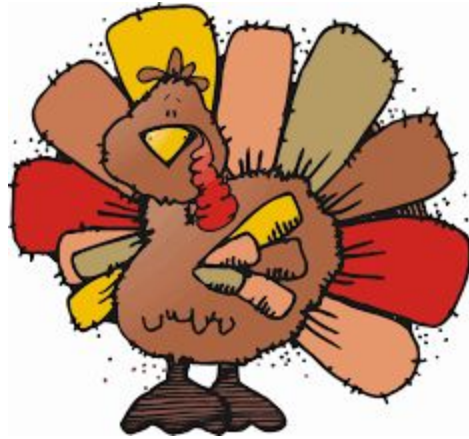


November News
