March Learning Themes:

Dr. Seuss: During the first few weeks of March, we will celebrate the birthday of Dr. Seuss. We will read some of the children's favorite books written by Dr. Seuss himself. We will especially focus on words that rhyme (looking at the ending sounds of different words). We will play games and do fun science experiments incorporating some of the "silliness" that Dr. Seuss is known for 😊

Oceans: We couldn't head off to our spring break destinations without learning some interesting facts about the ocean. We will "dive deep" and have fun learning about the amazing life found under the ocean! We will end our ocean unit with a "Beach Party" in our classroom on Monday, March 27th (more info to come). As always, each of my themes incorporates all aspects of the curriculum. Math- numbers and shapes, Art- creativity and colors, Reading- letters and sounds, Social Studies- what is happening in the world around us (critical thinking skills).

Fieldtrip (MacPhail Center for Music):

On Thursday, March 1st we will be going on a fieldtrip to MacPhail Center for Music. We will be singing songs, playing instruments and
