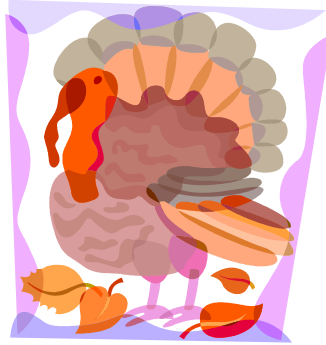


Mrs. Schubloom's Preschool News

We will end our theme with each child becoming an author and illustrator as they create a book of their own. It is sure to be a month full of color and creativity!
