2024-25 LHUMP Advisory Council




Early Childhood Screening

An Early Childhood Screening is a developmental and health check of your child. At screening, trained staff will check your child's development, hearing and vision, growth, immunizations and health history. It is recommended that all children be screened at age 3, but children can be screened at 4 or 5 as well. Early screening is recommended so that any health or learning concerns can be found early and help can be provided sooner. In Minneapolis, screening contact information: 612.668.3715 or screen@mpls.k12.mn.usln other districts, contact their ECFE. Screening is required by MN state law prior to the start of public-school Kindergarten.

Minneapolis School Request Time

On the Minneapolis Public School website, use the School Finder to see which schools are available to you based on your home address.





Once you know your options, contact the schools that interest you to take a tour or visit their open house. Open house events are scheduled this fall and winter to help families choose a school for the 2024-25 school year.

For the 2024-25 school year, request a school by Jan 31, 2024 to be included in the first school request lottery. School placement letters are then mailed out in the spring.
