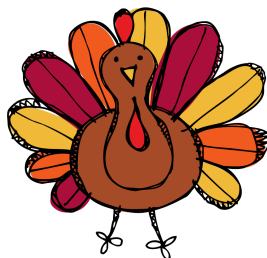


Transition/Older Toddler Room
