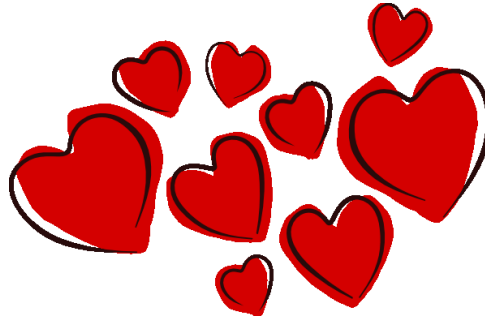


February Newsletter Room 203
