## 2025-26 Enrollment

For families enrolled in full-time preschool and childcare, please note that monthly tuition for summer remains due on the first of the month in May, June, and July. If your child is continuing in our program this fall, the first payment for the new school year will be due on August 1, 2025, ensuring no overlap in payments.

For part-time families returning to Lake Harriet UM Preschool in the fall, the yearly tuition deposit will be due by July 1, 2025.

Updated enrollment forms for **preschoolers** will be shared via Brightwheel in June, with a submission deadline of July 1, 2025. If your plans have changed and your child will not be returning in the fall, please let us know as soon as possible so we can offer the spot to a family on our waitlist.

## **NAEYC Annual Program Evaluation**

Thank you to everyone who completed an Annual Evaluation survey - we had a 85% response rate. If you didn't get a chance to complete a survey and would like to, please let us know. The results are overwhelmingly positive and we are very appreciative of your feedback. We use these results to evaluate our program and set goals for improvements. Here are some highlights:

#### **Access Year-End Tax Statement**

- 1. Navigate to the Payments page in your account
- 2. From the  $\boldsymbol{Accounts}$  tab, select a student's name to open their account
- 3. Open the **Statements** tab under the purple balance tile
- 4. Click **Export** next to the **Family 2024 payer tax statement** drop-down
- 5. **Download** or **Export** the statement and then open it
- 6. Use the **Total Payments** (if one payer) or **Paid by** tiles (if multiple payers) at the top of the statement to determine total payments made in the previous calendar year
- 7. Repeat these steps for additional students at the same or different brightwheel programs as needed
